Text	Works that contain a series of words or phrases, usually forming complete sentences that explain, or narrate, such as poems, stories, scripts, and instructions.
Editing	Adding, revising, or deleting preexisting text.
Photographs	Photographic prints, illustrations, or slides.
Artwork	Two- or three-dimensional artwork, illustrative matter such as drawings, technical drawings, or other non-photographic pictorial representations
Translation	Rendering a work from one language to another.
Compilation	A work formed by collecting and assembling preexisting materials in such a way that the resulting work as a whole constitutes an original work of authorship. To be copyrightable, a compilation must contain a certain amount of original selection/ordering. For example, the selection of only 3 poems from different authors would not be a copyrightable compilation.
